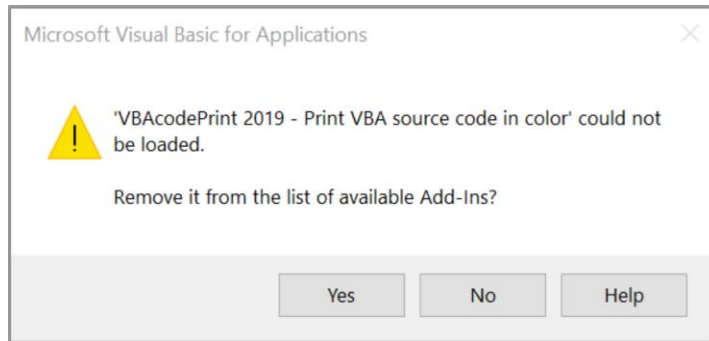
- Fixed Minor bugs

- Some code lines occupy two lines in the generated output instead of just one
- Fixed the bug that causes the following error message:

Fixed

- Options to change any color items does not always work
- Attempt to change options freeze the add-in and application host
- Connecting lines thickness is displayed as blank lines
- The preview window sometimes is blank
- Every time an attempt to change the Connecting Lines color, both VBAcodePrint and MS Excel freeze and I have to end the processes in Task Manager
- Export to a file that is open in another application causes VBAcodePrint to crash
- The generated output contains extra space after some characters (like :)
- Indentation is slightly too wide and that causes comments at the end of each line to look misaligned as shows below:
